Required Documentation

- Identification for all household members, including SSNs
- □ Proof of Income (for ALL household members age 18+) for the last 4 weeks
- Household members who are 18 or older, with No Income, must sign a No-Income form as well as an application addendum.
 - Full Time Students must submit a letter from school confirming student status in addition to income information.
 - Heating, Electric and Gas bills

REQUIRED FOR HOMEOWNERS:

- Mortgage Statement
- Property Taxes
- Homeowner's Insurance

REQUIRED FOR RENTERS:

- □ Lease/Rental Agreement or Rent Receipt
- Landlord's Name, Address & Phone
- Copy of Tenant Profile (Section 8 Only)

First time applicants must complete a face to face interview.

Returning applicants may re-certify through the mail.

Other documents may be required.
